


Marquette Creek is an important spawning stream for Yellowstone cutthroat trout, and for most of the year the population consists primarily of juvenile fish. Though the stream segment is entirely on Forest Service land, it is best accessed via private land. Contact fisheries biologists in the Cody regional office to get contact information of the landowner if you want to visit this instream flow segment.
