


Driving Directions: From the town of Greybull in the Bighorn Basin, take Highway 14 east. The instream flow segment begins at the national forest boundary about 4 miles east of the town of Shell and extends about 6 miles upstream to Shell Falls. There's a pull-out near the forest boundary where you can easily walk over to the stream. Road access at more upstream points is difficult as the highway switch-backs up the mountainside and grows progressively further away from the stream. There's a visitor information center at Shell Falls but fishing access from this point is technically challenging.
