## Standardized Walk-In Area Denotations

<u>A- Designated Parking Areas</u>	
*A	All vehicles must park in designated parking areas only.
*A	1 Parking along county road only.
<u>B-Blind restrictions</u>	
*B	Portable blinds may be used on a daily basis. Blinds must have owner's name and contact info affixed and may not be left in the field overnight.
*B	1 Except on unharvested crops , portable blinds may be used on a daily basis . Blinds must have owner's name and contact info affixed and may not be left in the field overnight.
<u>D-Motorized vehicle access on designated roads.</u>	
*D	Motorized vehicle access limited to designated roads only. Designated roads are marked with a white arrow .
*D	1 Through-access on designated road allowed 5/16 – 11/30.
<u>E-Motorized vehicle access on established roads.</u>	
*E	Motorized vehicle access allowed on established roads only.
<u>F-ORV travel restrictions</u>	
*F	NO ORVs.
*F	1 ORVs may travel on established roads for game retrieval only.
*F	2 ORVs may travel on established roads after 12:00 PM each day for game retrieval only.
<u>H- Hunting stipulations</u>	
*H	Hunters allowed to hunt off horseback .
*H	1 Archery hunting only. Archers must wear fluorescent orange during the firearm season.
*H	2 No hunting in pastures with livestock.
*H	3 No access within 100 yards of buildings .
*H	4 No hunting in cornfield until after crop is completely harvested.
*H	5 Each hunter must sign-in before hunting (every trip).
*H	6 Firearms may not be carried on ORV during retrieval.
*H	7 Rifle and pistol use prohibited.
<u>J- Date specific info</u>	
*J	Closed October 1 - 31.
*J	1 No elk hunting October 1 - 15.
*J	2 Access allowed only during waterfowl season as published by the Game & Fish Department. Access provided within 100 yards of highwater line and from parking area to nearest point on river only.
<u>L-Landowner Coupon info</u>	
*L	Please deposit landowner coupons in containers provided on this Walk-in Area.
<u>M-Misc. Mixed denotations</u>	
*M	Dogs must be under owner's control.
<u>P-Predator hunting info</u>	
*P	Predator hunting allowed during daylight hours only.
*P	1 Coyote hunting allowed during daylight hours only.
<u>R-Restrictions on Species/Sex</u>	
*R	Antlerless elk hunting only.
*R	1 Antlerless deer hunting only.
*R	2 Mountain lion hunting allowed.
*R	3 Fall black bear hunting allowed .
*R	4 Ruffed grouse hunting allowed.
*R	5 Crow hunting allowed during open season.

*R	6	Prairie dog hunting allowed.
*R	7	Nongame hunting permitted .
*R	8	Duck hunting only. No goose hunting.
*R	9	White-tailed deer hunting only. No mule deer hunting.
*R	0	Moose hunting allowed.
<b>S- State Land info</b>		
*S		State lands are enrolled in this Walk-in Area. All access restrictions apply.
<b>T- Trapping</b>		
*T		No trapping allowed.
<b>V- Vehicle Access/Travel Info</b>		
*V		Travel restricted to highways and county roads when conditions are wet or muddy.
*V	1	Vehicle access from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM only. Roads closed all other times.
*V	2	Vehicles may travel on established roads after 11:00 AM for game retrieval only. Firearms are not allowed in vehicles during game retrieval.
*V	3	No vehicles allowed on irrigated acreage.
*V	4	Access via Black Hills National Forest.
*V	5	Vehicle travel restricted to Forest Service roads (FS 913 & FS 914).
*V	6	Absolutely no access south of Beaver Creek . Beaver Creek Road is not public. The only access is via the Schoonover Road (Johnson County) and Buffalo Cut Across Road (Campbell County).
*V	7	Vehicle access via Birdseye Pass Road (Fremont Co. Rd . 170). Road closed from Birdseye Pass to Walk-in Area when muddy.
*V	8	Access via Jade Road.
*V	9	Access via Soldier Creek Road (CR 74).
*V	10	Vehicle access via Old Highway 85 in Weston County.
